

This snow route in the event of heavy snowfall conditions (15 cm +) or extreme weather conditions such as freezing rain.

If you choose to use bus service on these days it will be the responsibility of the families to get to the alternate stops, in many instances students will have to cross busy roads and travel a fair distance to get the bus service. The main concern is the safety of the students on the bus during these hazardous conditions to avoid the bus getting stuck at the stops and avoid any roads that may be problematic.

Please read the reverse side for the procedures for finding out if snow routes are in effect.

This route has been planned out in an attempt to keep some form of bus service available to the families.
