It is with deep satisfaction that I wish to inform you of a possible return to school in all Conseil scolaire francophone (CSF) of British Columbia's schools on Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Following an agreement between the BCPSEA (BC Public School Employers' Association) and the BCTF (BC Teachers' Federation) the teachers of the public system of British Columbia will vote on the cessation of their protest movement on Thursday, September 18<sup>th</sup>.

I would like to emphasize the fact that this possible return to school on Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup> will depend on the September 18<sup>th</sup> vote results.

In the meantime, the CSF's Head Office is finalizing, in collaboration with the School Principals and the Teachers' Union, the last terms to make this return to school a memorable time for all students. School bus companies have been informed, if they haven't already contacted you, they will by the end of the week.

On Friday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, I will send you a more detailed letter concerning the organization of the first week of school.
